
About the Programme

The IFY provides <u>direct entry to the 1st year of a university degree</u> (or entry onto the NCUK International Year One).




How does it work?

Choose 3 subject modules linked to your university study preferences, boost your academic English and develop key skills – all to help you gain entry to university and help you succeed when you get there.


*The English language module that you study will depend on your English language level when you start the programme.

English language module

Inversity Access Centre




NCUK's English language module develops your skills in speaking, listening, writing, and reading, with tailored levels based on your current English proficiency. You will study one of three English language modules based on your English language proficiency.

NCUK's English language modules show that you:

can communicate effectively orally and in writing in an academic environment

understand academic integrity and can demonstrate it in your work

have a level of English that enables you to meet the challenges of disciplinary study at university



Skills-based module





NCUK's skills-based module (Skills for Success) is fully online and is studied alongside your subject and English language modules.

This module will enable you to learn and develop essential academic and transferable skills including:


Certificate & transcript



Entry Requirements





To gain entry onto the NCUK International Foundation Year, you must meet the entry requirements with either:

- Completion of local high/secondary school
- Completion of IGCSE/O Levels/GCSE's with 5 modules at grade 4 or above (normally to include English and Maths)
- You are also required to hold an English language qualification equivalent to IFLTS 5.0

NCUK can provide an English test for students to take prior to the course, if they do not already have a result*.



Significantly reduce overall costs

By choosing to study our internationally recognised Foundation Programme here in the Kingdom, students can enjoy the comfort of their culture and family support—while avoiding the risk that affects 12–15% of students who go abroad too soon, many of whom struggle academically and culturally, leading to early dropout.

Soft Landing

Drop Out rates during or post-foundation sits at between 12-15% in the UK, with lack of preparedness for the academic and culture shock being the lead reasons.

With <u>exactly</u> the same curriculum, progression routes and university acceptance guarantees as a student studying in the UK, we can use the year to prepare them for the required academic rigor and cultural expectations without the overwhelming shock of directly starting abroad.
